Instructions: Place the response form in front of the participant. Read aloud the instructions.

Say:

"Look at these boxes. Notice that each has a number in the upper part and a special mark in the lower part. Each number has its own mark. Now look down here where the squares have numbers in the top part but the squares at the bottom are empty (point to the sample items).

"In each of the empty squares put the mark that should go there, like this: Here is a 2; the 2 has this mark so I put it in this square like this. Here is a 1; the 1 has this mark, so I put it in this square. This number is 3; the 3 has this mark, so I put it in this square (examiner fills in first three boxes to demonstrate).

"Now you fill in the squares up to this heavy line." (If participant makes errors, continue to help until all sample items are filled in correctly.)

"Now you know how to do them. When I tell you to start, you do the rest of them. Begin here and fill in as many squares as you can, one after the other, without skipping any. Keep working until I tell you to stop. Work as quickly as you can without making any mistakes. When you finish this line, go on to this one. Ready? Begin."

Allow 2 minutes for the test.
